Objective: To know that God is *faithful* and He always keeps His promise.

<u>Background:</u> After Adam and Eve disobeyed God's words, God promised that one day He would send a Savior to earth to save the people from sin (Gen.3:1-5; 12:1-3). Since then God had been preparing the history for the coming of the Savior. And the promise given long ago was *finally fulfilled* at the birth of Jesus two thousand years ago. He was born in Palestine, a tiny country under the rule of Roman Empire (Gal. 4:4, 5).

<u>Introduction:</u> Read over carefully Luke 1 :26-38; Matthew 1 :18-25; and Luke 2:1-7 before you answer the questions.

Let's Think:

- 1. Jot down what you know about Mary at the time when she learned that she will be with a child (Give Scripture references). In what way will the birth of this child *be different* from the birth of *all* others? What's significant about this truth? and Why?
- 2. What was Mary's initial response to the news? and why? Do you observe any *change* in her feelings and attitude as the event unfolded? Read carefully Lk. 1:29, 34, 38.
- 3. Was Mary aware of the predicament she would be in by being *obedient* to God? But, how was her problem solved? (Mt. 1:18-21)
- 4. What's significant about Lk. 2:1-7 and Mt. 2:1-6 in the light of Micah 5:2, which was spoken some 700 years earlier? Explain *how history served the purpose of God*. Locate the places on a map.
- 5. Was there a "media coverage" of the birth of Jesus? How do you describe this "epoch-making" event? Can the significance of an event be measured by the amount of publicity given? Give your reason.
- 6. How do the names "Jesus" and "Emmanuel" signify the purpose of His birth? Explain. (Read
- carefully Mt. 1:21, 23; In. 1:14) By the way, has that purpose been accomplished in your life? Take time to reflect.
- 7. What glimpse of God do you gain through this study? Read also In. 3:16. Is He *your* God? Do you know Him *personally?*

<u>Let's Remember: "But when the time had fully come, God sent forth His Son, born of woman, ..."</u> (Galatians 4:4). An angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph saying, ". ..she (Mary) will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sin." (Matthew 1:21)
