Lesson 1 **The Birth of Jesus**

Objective:	To learn that God is <u>faithful</u> and He always keeps His promise.	
Background:	After Adam and Eve sinned against God (they disobeyed God's Word), God promised that one day He would send a Savior (Jesus) to earth to save men from sin. (Genesis 3:1-15; 12:11-3 in the Old Testament) Even though thousands of years passed, God remembered His promise. He did send Jesus about two thousand years ago, born in Palestine, a tiny Jewish country in the far eastern corner of the Roman Empire. (See the map.)	
Instruction:	Please read Luke 1:26-38; Matthew 1:18-25; Luke 2:1-7 at least twice before you do the lesson.
