<u>Follow Jesus' Steps</u> Children/Youth

Lesson 34: The Resurrection

<u>Objective:</u> To learn that we Christians worship and serve a Savior who is <u>living</u> today.

<u>Background:</u> "It is finished," said Jesus triumphantly as He was dying on the cross. For He had

accomplished the purpose (goal) for which He came to earth – to pay the penalty for sin; to die in the place of sinners. He was buried and on the third day (Sunday) He rose again from the dead never to die again. He has conquered death! All the religion in the world worship "dead teachers", but Christians alone worship a "living Savior", Jesus lives today! And that is the Good News.

Instructions: Read carefully Mark 15:42-47; Matthew 27:62-66; Lluke 23:35 to 24:43 as if you

were at the scene.

Let's Think:

Friday around 4 or 5 p.m., Jesus was buried in a hurry because the Sabbath day, a <u>holy day</u> began at 6 p.m. The Jewish religious laws forbit (do not allow) leaving a dead body hanging on a cross overnight or to bury the dead on the Sabbath day. So, they wrapped Jesus' body in a linen cloth and placed it in a nearby tomb which no one had used. Let us see what happens since Jesus died on the cross at 3 p.m. Friday afternoon.

1. a) What did Pilate do before he gave the body of Jesus to Joseph of Arimathea? (Matthew 15:42-47; John 19:31-34) And where did Joseph bury Jesus? (Matthew 27:59-61)

b) Why did it take courage for Joseph of Arimathea to ask for Jesus' body? Explain

2. a) When did the religious leaders go to see Pilate again? Why were they in such a hurry since they had succeeded in killing Jesus? (Matthew 27:62-66)

b) What did Pilate tell them to do? Had they tried? Did it work? Explain

3.	a)	Had Jesus really said that He would rise from the dead? (Matthew 16:21; Matthew 17:22,23; Matthew 20:17-19) And has He really risen from the dead?
4.	a)	What did Peter and John see when they ran to the tomb? (John 20:4-7)
	b)	What <u>evidence</u> is there that Jesus body was not stolen either by His disciples or by His enemies as some said, but that Jesus really rose from the dead <u>physically?</u>
5.		Read Luke 24:13-35; John 20:19-29 and write down the names of people, besides Mary Magdalene, who saw Jesus after he rose from the dead.
